

# 2010 Election Information for Iredell County

- **FILING**

- **February 8<sup>th</sup> at 12 noon - February 26 at 12 noon** -- State & County Offices & School Board
- **June 14<sup>th</sup> at 12 noon - July 2 at 12 noon** – Soil & Water District Supervisor

- **ELECTION DAY**

- **May 4, 2010** -- 1<sup>st</sup> Primary Election
- **June 22, 2010** -- 2<sup>nd</sup> Primary Election (if necessary)
- **November 2, 2010** – General Election

- **VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES**

- **April 9, 2010** – Last day to register, change your party affiliation, or change your address for the Primary Election. (GS 163-82.6 (c)(1))
- **October 8, 2010** – Last day to register, change your party affiliation, or change you address for the General Election. (GS 163-82.6 (c)(1))

- **ONE-STOP VOTING** will be held at the Board of Elections Office at 203 Stockton Street in Statesville. (Other sites may be available – please call the BOE office at 704-878-3140 for updates.)

- **Primary Election:** One Stop voting begins April 15<sup>th</sup> at 8 am and ends on Saturday, May 1<sup>st</sup> at 1 pm. (May 1<sup>st</sup> is the only Saturday)
- **General Election:** One Stop voting begins October 14 at 8 am and ends on Saturday, Oct. 30<sup>th</sup> at 1 pm. (October 30<sup>th</sup> is the only Saturday)

- **POLLING PLACES**

- **All polling places are open on Election Day from 6:30 am – 7:30 pm.**
- To find your polling place go to [www.sboe.nc.us](http://www.sboe.nc.us). Click Voter Registration/Check your registration/Show me my voter information/enter your first name, last name, and date of birth and SUBMIT. This will bring up all your voter information. Scroll down the page to **MY POLLING LOCATION**. You will see your polling place as well as have access to a map of the location.

- **ABSENTEE BALLOTS**

- **March 15, 2010** - Beginning date to request an absentee ballot for the Primary election
- **April 27, 2010** -- Last day to request an absentee ballot for the Primary election
- **May 3, 2010** -- All voted absentee ballots must be returned to the BOE by 5 pm.
  
- **September 3, 2010** – Beginning date to request an absentee ballot for the General Election
- **October 26, 2010** -- Last day to request an absentee ballot for the General election
- **November 1, 2010** -- All voted absentee ballots must be returned to BOE by 5 pm.

Absentee ballots can be requested in person at the Board of Elections Office or by sending a written request to the Iredell County Board of Elections. Written requests must be received in the office no later than the Tuesday prior to Election Day. In order to be counted, the voted ballot must be received in the Board of Elections office by 5:00 pm on the day before the Election.

**Absentee ballots may be requested by:**

1. The voter
2. The voter's near relative (spouse, brother, sister, parent, grandparent, child, grandchild, mother-in-law, father-in-law, daughter-in-law, son-in-law, stepparent, or stepchild).
3. The voter's verifiable legal guardian.

**Note: No one with POWER OF ATTORNEY is allowed to sign for a voter unless she/he is the voter's near relative or the voter's verifiable legal guardian.**

**To request an absentee ballot by mail**, send a handwritten note to the Board of Elections with the following information:

- Voter's full name
- Voter's residence in Iredell County
- Address the ballot should be mailed to
- Voter's Party affiliation (only for a primary election)
- Unaffiliated voters should state which party's ballot they wish to vote.
- Voter's date of birth
- Voter's daytime phone number
- Voter's signature (or signature of near relative or legal guardian and relationship to voter)
