

# 2012 Election Schedule for Iredell County

- **FILING**
  - **February 13, 2012 at 12:00 noon – February 29, 2012 noon** – State & County Offices and School Board
  - **June 11, 2012 at 12:00 noon - July 6, 2012 at 12:00 noon** – Soil & Water District Supervisor
- **ELECTION DAY**
  - **May 8, 2012** -- 1<sup>st</sup> Primary Election
  - **June 26, 2012** -- 2<sup>nd</sup> Primary Election, if necessary (7 weeks) GS-163-111(3)(e)
  - **July 17, 2012** – 2<sup>nd</sup> Primary Election (10 weeks if a Federal Office is involved) GS-163-111(3)(e)
  - **November 6, 2012** – General Election
- **VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES**
  - **April 13, 2012** – Last day to register, change your party affiliation, or change your address for the Primary Election. GS-163-82.6(c)(1) & GS-163-82(h)
  - **October 12, 2012** – Last day to register, change your party affiliation, or change you address for the General Election. GS-163-82.6(c)(1)
- **ABSENTEE BALLOTS**
  - **March 19, 2012** - Beginning date to request an absentee ballot for the Primary Election.
  - **May 1, 2012** -- Last day to request an absentee ballot for the Primary Election
  - **May 7, 2012** -- All voted absentee ballots must be returned to the BOE by 5 pm.
  
  - **September 7, 2012** – Beginning date to request an absentee ballot for the General Election
  - **October 30, 2012** -- Last day to request an absentee ballot for the General Election
  - **November 5, 2012** -- All voted absentee ballots must be returned to BOE by 5 pm.

**To request an absentee ballot**, mail a handwritten note to the Board of Elections with the following:

- Voter's full name
- Voter's residence address in Iredell County
- Address the ballot should be mailed to
- Voter's date of birth
- Voter's signature
- Voter's daytime phone number
- **For the Primary Election only**, Unaffiliated voters should state which party's ballot they wish to vote

Begins Thursday, April 19, 2012 at 8 am and ends on Saturday, May 5, 2012 at 1 pm  
Hours: M – F from 8 am to 6 pm  
Saturday: April 21 (closed) April 28 (8 am – 1 pm) May 5 (8 am – 1 pm)
  - **WAR MEMORIAL BUILDING** -- 220 N. Maple Street Mooresville, NC  
Begins Thursday, April 26 at 11 am and ends Friday, May 4<sup>th</sup> at 7 pm.  
Hours: M – F from 11 am to 7 pm and on Saturday, April 28 from 8 am to 1 pm

**There is no One-Stop (early voting) on Monday, May 7th**

- **POLLING PLACES**
  - **All polling places are open on Election Day from 6:30 am – 7:30 pm.**
  - To find your polling place go to [www.ncsbe.gov](http://www.ncsbe.gov). Click on MY ELECTION INFORMATION/Show me my voter information/enter your first name, last name, and date of birth (using the mm/dd/yyyy format) and SUBMIT. This will bring up all your voter information. Scroll down the page to **MY POLLING LOCATION**. You will see your polling place as well as have access to a map of the location.
