The City of Statesville is working with the N.C. Department of Transportation and other partners to create a Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) for the Statesville area.

The CTP will analyze transportation needs through the year 2040 and recommend improvements to highways, public transportation, bicycle and pedestrian facilities. Although the CTP does not schedule or fund the improvements, it is an essential step in the process.
