Definitions & Fees for Iredell County

- A. **Commercial/Industrial Waste:** *All solid waste generated from but not limited to factories, restaurants, business firms and institutions. Consists of but not limited to manufactured materials, manufacturing by-products, raw materials, carpet and padding, plastics, paper, cloth, sweepings, paper tubing & general business trash.*
Fee: \$48.00 per ton
- B. **Construction and Demolition Waste:** *Consists of but not limited to wood (inc. treated & painted), windows, vinyl siding, sheetrock, insulation, paneling, cabinets, fixtures, carpeting, vinyl flooring and other types of installed flooring. Only one level pickup load will be accepted at this facility. No C&D waste will be accepted after 6 p.m. Concrete, asphalt, brick and block, uncontaminated dirt, gravel, rocks, shingles and land clearing debris that consists of vegetated growth, trees and dirt will not be accepted at this facility. Large loads and unacceptable materials will be directed to the Statesville facility.*
Fee: \$48.00 per ton
- C. **CRT (Cathode Ray Tube) TV's and Monitors:** *Cathode ray tubes or CRT television and computer monitors can be identified as the older picture tube units. These are banned from the landfill and are required to be recycled by state law.*
Fee: \$10.00 per unit
- D. **Household:** *Materials generated by the day to day housekeeping activities of a single family residential unit; including kitchen waste, food packaging, clothing, toys, floor sweepings and furniture. There will be no charge for these materials for residences that have paid the Solid Waste Availability Fee.*
- E. **North Carolina SW Disposal Tax:** *A \$2.00 per ton disposal tax will be added to all weight landfilled in the State of North Carolina.*
- F. **Recycled Materials:** *Consists of glass, aluminum cans, steel cans, mixed paper, cardboard, plastic, motor oil, anti-freeze, batteries and scrap metal. Must be source separated.*
Fee: No charge
- G. **Special Handling Fee:** *A one-time fee of the price per ton will be added to the tipping fee for any material disposed of that requires assistance with a piece of equipment to unload or that requires removal by solid waste employees due to being on the list of banned materials by NCDEQ.*
- H. **Tires:** *Homeowners are entitled to dispose of five (5) tires per year off the rim. Any tires on the rim will be assessed a fee.*
Fee: \$100.00/ton off-rim, \$150/ton on-rim

- I. **White Goods:** *Consists of refrigerators, stoves, freezers, air conditioners, hot water heaters, washers, dryers and water coolers. Must be kept separate from MSW.*
Fee: *No charge*
- J. **Yard Waste:** *Consists of materials generated from the routine maintenance of the defined lawn area of improved properties that have been assessed the Solid Waste Availability Fee. Included are items such as old firewood, clean leaves, grass clippings, shrubbery, limbs and cut trees under 8 inch diameter and no longer than 8 feet. No stumps of any size accepted. Loads larger than a secure pickup load will be directed to the Statesville facility.*
Fee: *No charge*

All incoming loads are required by NC State law to be covered or secured.

Businesses are encouraged to call the Solid Waste Facility at (704) 663-5314 with questions or concerns about any item for disposal.

NC State permit does not allow out of county waste to be accepted at any of our facilities. All accepted waste must be generated from within the county.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED AT THIS FACILITY

- *No animals (required to be disposed of at our Statesville facility)*
- *No asbestos*
- *No land clearing debris*
- *No pallets*
- *No burnt wood, trash or ashes*
- *No liquids of any type*
- *No hazardous materials*
- *No trailers over 10' in length or double loads; will be directed to Statesville*
