

Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) Amendments Public Meetings

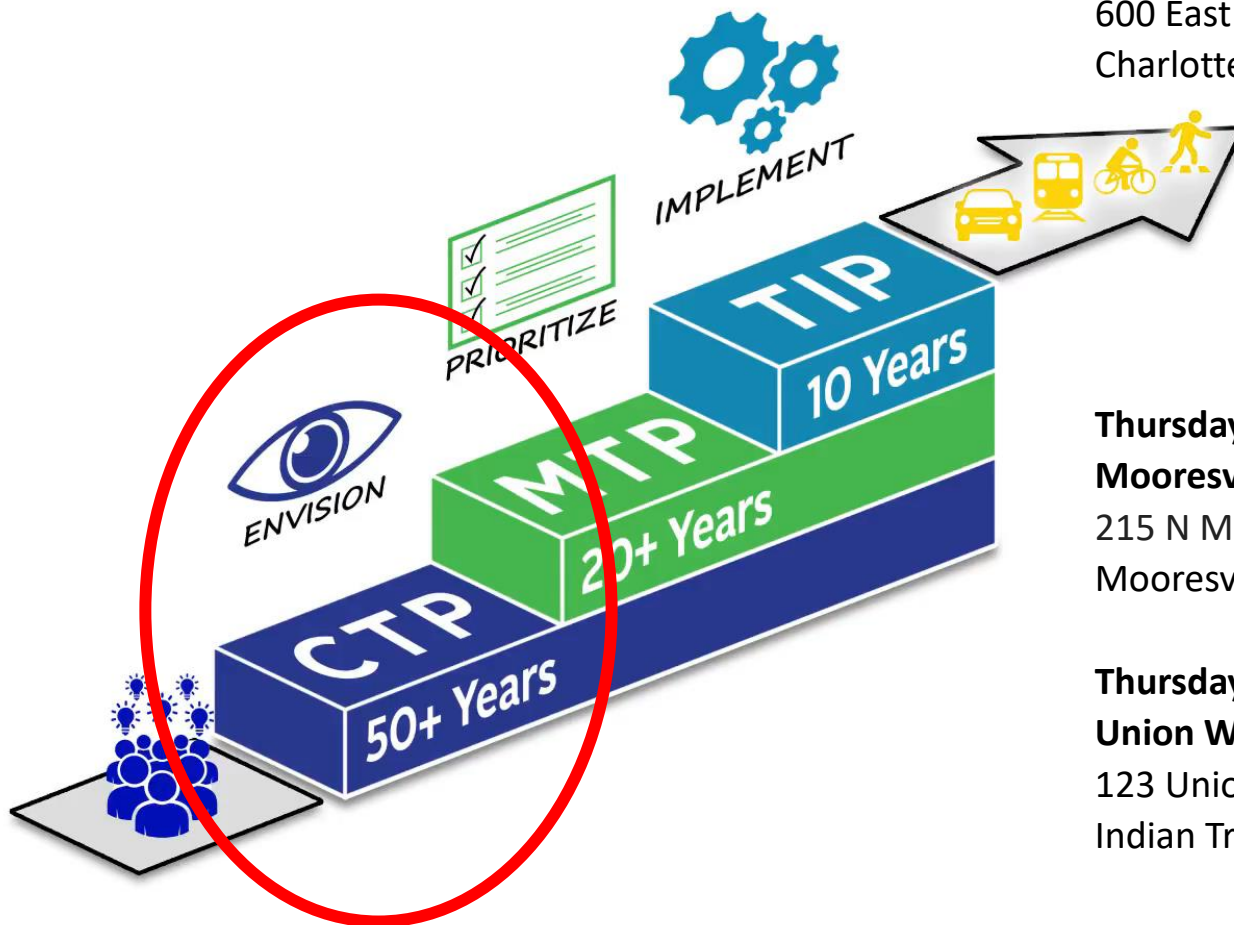
The Charlotte Regional Transportation Planning Organization (CRTPO) is hosting three public meetings for public comment on the proposed CTP amendments.

The CTP is the long-range plan identifying future needs to the transportation network, from roadways and transit to bicycle and pedestrian accommodations. It provides the foundation for what will become the transportation priorities over the next 50+ years.

The CTP is amended periodically to incorporate updates to local and county transportation plans, completed transportation projects, and evolving assessments of the transportation network. CRTPO is presenting the current series of proposed amendments from its member jurisdictions for roadway and bicycle projects.
