Who Should Get Vaccinated?

Two Doses Needed



School-aged children
(2nd dose at 4-6 years of age)



High Risk Adults:

College Students



Healthcare Personnel



International Travelers

One Dose of Vaccine Needed

Adults not at high risk & born in the U.S. in 1957 or later

Vaccine NOT Needed:

- Previously received the vaccine
- Lab test showing protection from disease
- Born in U.S. before 1957 and not at high risk

What is Measles?

Measles is a highly contagious respiratory disease spread when an infected person coughs or sneezes. It is dangerous and can be deadly, for people of all ages.
